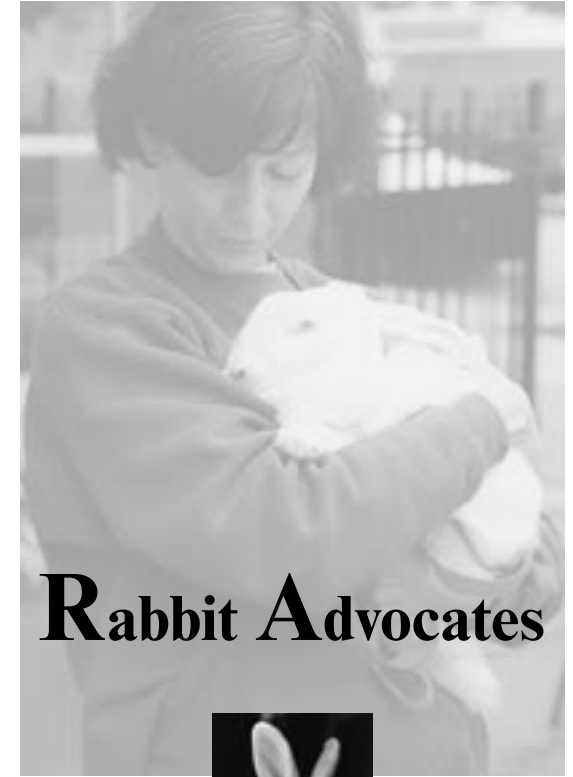

Education

Foster care

Rabbits in need of temporary housing or special care find shelter with volunteer foster parents.
